- Academic Scholarships are awarded based on the results of the independent academic test and an interview, at the discretion of the Scholarships Committee.
- The Arts Scholarship is awarded based on the written application, supporting documentation and an interview, at the discretion of the Scholarships Committee.
- 3. Students may apply for more than one scholarship. A reference to a "Scholarship" in this document refers to an Academic Scholarship, The Arts Scholarship (as the context requires).
